## The Director

The director this year will be **Christopher Uhl**. Mr. Uhl is the Director of Music at the Hoosac School, Hoosick, New York, an Episcopal college preparatory boarding school. Prior to his present appointment, he was Music Director and Organist of the Cathedral Church of the Immaculate Conception, Mobile, Alabama, for nine years. Subsequently, he was Assistant Professor of Music at the Alabama School of Mathematics and Science and the Music Director of Saint Ignatius Church, both in Mobile. Mr. Uhl has conducted in major churches of Paris, Venice, Florence, and Rome. In 1995, he was named a Fellow of the Orchestral Conductors Institute at the University of South Carolina in Columbia. He received his training at Westminster Choir College, Princeton, New Jersey, and he was an Organ Scholar at Saint Thomas Church Fifth Avenue, New York City. He pursued further study in Rome, studying Gregorian Chant and modal harmony with James Goettsche, the Vatican organist. Mr. Uhl most recently conducted the *Requiem* of Maurice Duruflé in the context of a pre-Vatican II High Requiem Mass in the Mobile Cathedral.

Christopher Uhl, son of Mr. and Mrs. Don J. Uhl of Van Wert, is the grandson of Mr. and Mrs. Albert Uhl, (both born in Venedocia) and the grand-nephew of Mr. and Mrs. J. Alford Breese, long-time Choir Director and Organist of Salem Presbyterian Church in Venedocia.

## Soloist & Accompanists

Soloist **Joe Consiglio**, a tenor, studied voice at Washington University earning a graduate degree in vocal performance. After moving to New York City, he studied with acclaimed voice teacher Cornelius Reid. Mr. Consiglio has appeared in roles with the Union Avenue Opera, the Midland Reparatory Opera and the University of Huston Opera. He has also appeared as a soloist with the Bach Society of St. Louis and with the Trinity Presbyterian Choir in Van Wert. This will be his first appearance as a soloist in the Gymanfa Ganu.

Joe lives in Evergreen Park, a suburb of Chicago with his wife, Sarah, (a Van Wert native), their son, Anthony, and their daughter, Charlotte.

**Connie O'Neill** is playing the organ. She is the daughter of the late Haydn and Marvel Lloyd and lives in New Bremen.

**LaDonna Allenbaugh** is playing the organ. LaDonna is our full time organist at Salem Church. She is married to Robert Allenbaugh, and they reside in Ohio City.
