TEACHING POINTS

Teaching Point One: *The Holy Spirit empowers us to do God's work.*

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE

“When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future.”

ACTION POINT

The word for Holy Spirit is *pneuma*, which comes from the same root word as wind *pneo* which means “to breathe or to blow.” In Genesis, God “breathed” or “blew” into man, and he became a living soul. This was the beginning of human life. In Acts, when the Holy Spirit blew upon or breathed upon the followers of Christ who obediently waited, they received a newness of life that would stun their peers. Why not likewise, wait and pray for the Spirit of God to come into your life and the life of our church. Ask God to breathe new life into each of us today!
