

Rev. Thomas Emery "Know the Fullness of God" Ephesians 3:14-21 Salem Presbyterian Church July 26, 2015

In our passage in Ephesians, Paul prays for three things for that Ephesian church. He prays that God will strengthen them by His Spirit; he prays that Christ will dwell in their hearts by faith, and he prays that they are rooted and established in love.

Paul didn't just tell the church to do merely these three. He realized the church isn't designed to operate like a purely social organization. The church can exist on its own, but it can't thrive and fulfill its mission for God. If it could survive on its own, it would be a human effort, dictated by the wealthy and influential, and led by the highly successful. If a church tries to go it alone without praying for God's presence and power, then that congregation runs amuck by having all kinds of carnal problems.

TEACHING POINTS

Teaching Point One: *God's love is not like our love.*

Teaching Point Two: *God's acceptance is not based upon our performance.*

Teaching Point Three: We need to work on our side of the relationship.

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE

"And may you have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is." Ephesians 3:18

ACTION POINT

Paul presses for the understanding that the love of Christ surpasses all knowledge. It is our human nature to want to control every situation and to provide all that is necessary to complete tasks or remedy challenging circumstances. Nevertheless, if we will surrender ourselves to God's will for us to love God and to love our neighbor as ourself and in prayer allow God to do His part, we will be filled with all the riches and understanding that the conditions require. In Matthew 25, we have some specifics of how we love God by loving one another. Our side of the contract requires us to feed the hungry, clothe the naked, and visit the sick and imprisoned. Let's turn our ministry over to God and as the author of Proverbs advises: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not rely on your own insight" (Proverbs 3:5). So, let's allow God to be God and to do what is possible only with God. As we do our contribution, God will fill in the gaps and complete the mission.
