

In our passage today, God instructs Hosea to marry a promiscuous Israelite woman named Gomer. Although many understand this command as somewhat inappropriate or a harm to the prophet's ministry, one should not protect Hosea's reputation by interpreting this story as a parable or a dream. There is no doubt that God wants the marriage of Hosea and the adulterous Gomer to represent God's covenant marriage with the two-timing Israel. All of these unusual acts effectively communicate God's truth to audiences that are too stubborn to listen to any "normal" or traditional presentation of God's Word so God needed another way to communicate as well as this is how the Canaanites worshipped their god of fertility.

### TEACHING POINTS

**POINT ONE** – *Like Gomer, we have sought other gods.* 

**POINT TWO**—And as Paul taught in the New Testament "... the wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23), we need to take serious our faithfulness to God.

**POINT THREE** – Our God is obsessed with love for us.

### THIS WEEK'S VERSE
